#### Tell Congress to provide an inflationary update to the physician fee schedule

Members can contact their representatives and urge them to increase Medicare payments by cosponsoring H.R. 2474.

Since 2001, the cost of operating a medical practice has increased 47%, while economy-wide inflation rose 73%. During this time, Medicare hospital and nursing facility updates have increased by roughly 70%, significantly outpacing physician reimbursement. Adjusted for inflation in practice costs, Medicare payments to physician practices declined 26% from 2001 to 2023, according to an AMA analysis of Medicare Trustees data. Physician practices need positive, inflation-based reimbursement updates to maintain financial stability and ensure patients have continued access to care.

You can ask your patients can urge Congress to act. Please encourage them to contact their Federal Representatives to support H.R. 2474.
