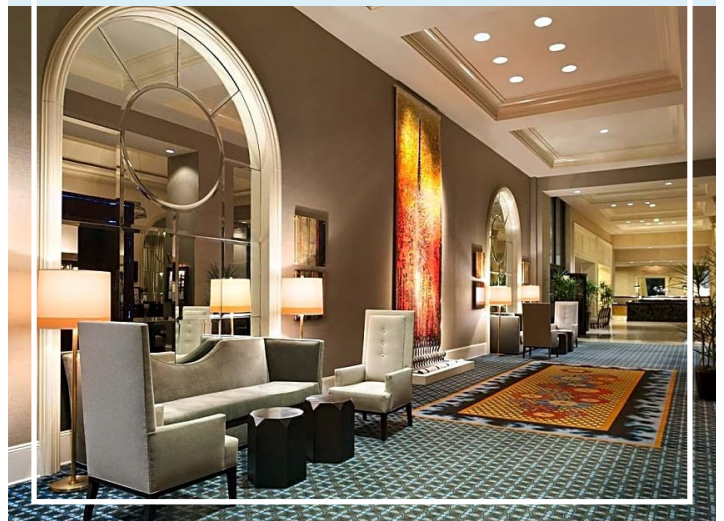

Hey Residents!

RESIDENT HOUSING STIPEND

The TDS offers a generous housing stipend to all Texas residents that are current TDS members who attend the conference. Each resident that applies for the stipend will be presented with a housing stipend reimbursement form at the resident lunch that will take place on **Friday, April 24th** at 11AM. This form should be filled out and returned to the TDS registration table or business office within a week of the conference. Each resident will have one night reimbursed in host hotel **at the discounted TDS room rate** or at another hotel for the same rate or lower. If the room booked is over the discounted TDS room rate, the room will be reimbursed at the room rate and the difference will be paid by the resident.

- ❖ Only current Texas residents who are TDS members can apply for and receive the stipend.
- ❖ Residents who reside in the host city are NOT eligible for the stipend.
- ❖ The TDS will only reimburse for one night TDS discounted hotel rate, applicable taxes, resort fee (if applicable) and one night of self-parking.
- ❖ If valet parking/food/extra charges are submitted for reimbursement, the TDS will deduct the appropriate amount and reimburse only for eligible expenses
